# IFB #22-2289-1LOC ANNUAL CONTRACT FOR HVAC MAINTENANCE and Repair

### **Questions and Answers**

- Q1. My firm have separate labor rates for chiller mechanics vs. mechanics that would work on all other HVAC equipment. Can my firm list our chiller mechanic rate as a separate line item?
- A1. No.
- Q2. Will there be a site visit of all these locations?
- A2. No.
- Q3. Do the County have a current master equipment list per building?
- A3. No, this solicitation is not for specific equipment.
- Q4. Are filters, belts and water treatment included in bid pricing?
- A4. See pages 5-6, section I.D.14.
- Q5. Will any equipment replacement occur under this contract or is the intent to only utilize the contract for maintenance and repairs of existing equipment and systems?
- A5. See page 2, section I.A. and page 8, section I.J.
- Q6. Would you clarify if the Emergency Hourly rate is during normal business hours or after hours?
- A6. Emergency Hourly rate shall apply when the County request the Successful Bidder(s) to respond to County site for emergency services (within two (2) hours after receiving call) during normal business hours or after hours.
- Q7. Since certain contractors may need to rent tools/equipment and said rentals would be billable at cost to the County; can a contractor that has invested in advanced tooling charge a per use tool fee, (if defined in advance), to cover costs of owning and maintaining these tools? (i.e., Thermal Imaging Camera, Gantries, High Volume Refrigerant Recovery Machines and Cylinders, Combustion Analyzers, Ultrasonic Flow Meters, Test and Balance Equipment?
- A7. See page 4, section I.D.11.

- Q8. In reference to Attachement E, item 9 "Clauses Required by 2 C.F.R. part 200 Appendix II(D)", Does the County anticipate any situations where the Davis Bacon wages clauses would be applicable to work that occurs as a result of this contract? If so, please describe.
- A8. The Davis-Bacon Act applies to contracts for the construction, alteration, or repair of a public building or public work over \$2,000 to which the United States or the District of Columbia is a party. Because neither the United States nor the District of Columbia will be a party to the contract, the Davis-Bacon Act will not apply. However, there are approximately 60 other federal laws, known as the "Related Acts" that make the prevailing wage requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act applicable to certain federally funded or federally assisted contracts. If federal funds are being used to pay for the contract, it is possible that some of those Related Acts would be applicable to the contract.
- Q9. On page 2, section I.A. of the IFB, it states the intent "...is to establish a term contract with two (2) or more qualified suppliers..." Is there a maximum number of suppliers that would be approved? If so, how many?
- A9. Yes, 4.
- Q10. How will the County ensure the selected Contractors are capable of performing the desired services?
- A10. See page 7, section I.H.1. and 2.
- Q11. Some repairs require higher percentages of labor that does not occur on a job site which is understood to be considered overhead as noted in section I.D.11. Does this imply that all work be performed and billed on a Time and Material Basis? Or will firm fixed price quoting be allowed under certain circumstances? If so, what would those circumstances be?
- A11. Yes, all work will be performed and billed on a time and material basis.
