This Non-Professional Services Contract (this "Contract") entered into this 29th day of July 2024, by ColonialWebb Contractors Company (the "Contractor") and the County of Henrico, Virginia and the County School Board of Henrico County, Virginia (collectively the "County").

**WHEREAS** the County has awarded the Contractor this Contract pursuant to Request for Proposals No. 24-2678-4BJM, as modified by Addendum No. 1, May 15, 2024 (the "Request for Proposals"), for On Call Plumbing Services.

**WITNESSETH** that the Contractor and the County, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and agreements herein contained, agree as follows:

**SCOPE OF CONTRACT:** The Contractor shall provide the services to the County as set forth in the Contract Documents.

**COMPENSATION:** The compensation the County will pay to the Contractor under this Contract shall be in accordance with Revised Attachment H (AD No. 1, 5.15.24), Pricing/Cost Proposal included in Exhibit C.

**CONTRACT TERM:** The Contract term shall be for a period of one year beginning August 1, 2024 and ending July 31, 2025. The County may renew the Contract for up to 4 one-year terms by giving 30 days' written notice before the end of the term unless the Contractor has given the County written notice that it does not wish to renew at least 90 days before the end of the term.

**CONTRACT DOCUMENTS:** This Contract hereby incorporates by reference the documents listed below (the "Contract Documents") which shall control in the following descending order:

# NEGOTIATED MODIFICATIONS TO AGREEMENT DOCUMENTS FOR CONTRACT NO. 2678A

These Negotiated Modifications are hereby incorporated into Contract No. 2678A (the "Contract") for On Call Plumbing Services as of the effective date of the Contract.

**WHEREAS**, the County and Contractor desire to agree in writing to modify the final terms and conditions of the Contract.

**THEREFORE,** in consideration of the Recital set forth above and good and valuable consideration as set forth in the Contract, the parties agree that the Contract Documents are modified as follows as of the date of the Contract:

1. ColonialWebb's proposal, page 35 of 46, Tab 7 Exceptions 2A. is hereby revised to the following:

**Exception: Water Jetter Limits of Liability:** Water jet operations entail the use of high volume and high-pressure water to clear pipes of accumulated materials on the walls of the pipes. Not knowing the latent condition of the pipes, joints, etc., the integrity of the piping system cannot be assured during or after Water Jetting Plumbing Services. Resultant damage not attributable to Successful Offeror's negligence or intentional misconduct, including but not limited to piping failures, water damage to floors or finishes and cleanup due to water backing out of drains or failure of pipes, shall be the responsibility of the County.

In addition, jet hoses may become stuck in drain piping due to defects or foreign matter. If excavation or mechanical means must be utilized for removal, an additional cost based on time and equipment will be charged to the County of Henrico. If removal is declined by the County of Henrico, they will be charged the retail cost of the damaged hose and nozzle.

By signing the Contract, the parties thereto have approved these Negotiated Modifications.

Thank you for the opportunity to negotiate final terms with Henrico County for this solicitation. Below are our responses to the two items requested in your letter dated July 10, 2024.

Not knowing the latent condition of the pipes, joints, etc., the integrity of the piping system cannot be assured during or after Water Jetting Plumbing Services. Resultant damage, including but not limited to piping failures, water damage to floors or finishes and cleanup due to water backing out of drains or failure of pipes, shall be the responsibility of the County of Henrico. The County of Henrico shall hold ColonialWebb harmless against any and all-resultant damage.

In addition, jet hoses may become stuck in drain piping due to defects or foreign matter. If excavation or mechanical means must be utilized for removal, an additional cost based on time and equipment will be charged to the County of Henrico. If removal is declined by the County of Henrico, they will be charged the retail cost of the damaged hose and nozzle.

• Item 2: Best & Final pricing for the project. ColonialWebb's pricing for this project is consistent with other public contracts with similar requirements. This was taken into consideration upon our original response to the solicitation. Therefore, the pricing we submitted in our original response is our best and final.

## Tab 6 – Pricing / Cost Proposal - Return Policy

## 1. Reference Page 8 of 40, Item II.B.14.i:

Offerors shall state in their Proposal, their policy on return of material, parts, and components.

## **ColonialWebb Contractors Return Policy:**

Parts or equipment that have been installed are not returnable.

Parts or equipment that have been purchased and not installed could be returned should a cancellation of work occur. Returns would be subject to the return policy of the wholesaler ColonialWebb utilized for the specific return in question. Generally, they would fall into two (2) categories:

- a. Stocked parts: Are returnable without a re-stocking fee.
- b. Special Ordered Parts generally have restocking fees. These fees are determined by the wholesaler and not ColonialWebb. These fees would be passed along at actual cost to the County of Henrico.





## Tab 7 – Exceptions

## 1. Reference Page 6 of 40, Item II.B.12.:

The Successful Offeror(s) shall invoice the County for services based on the hourly rates provided on their proposal. Hourly rates per man hour for plumbing services shall include all overhead, profit, insurance, union pension fund or contributions, workmen's compensation, unemployment insurance, social security, supervision, and truck usage, etc. The Successful Offeror(s) must pay its employees or contract workers, at a minimum, the wage levels required by federal and state law. **Time spent for transportation of workers, material acquisition, handling and delivery, fuel charges or for movement of Successful Offeror(s)'s owned or rental equipment is not chargeable directly but is overhead and the cost shall be included.** 

**Exception:** The last sentence of this section precludes charges for delivery of rental equipment. Rental companies typically charge their clients fees for delivery and thus this would be a real cost incurred by ColonialWebb and not affiliated with labor under our supervision required to mobilize work. Therefore, we request that we be able to invoice Henrico County for all costs that we incur directly associated with rental equipment.

## 2. Reference Page 7 of 40, Item II.B.14.a:

Successful Offeror(s) shall maintain a sufficient quantity of repair parts and standard equipment on hand or have ready access to these parts in order to prevent unnecessary downtime of equipment. Standard equipment necessary to perform all plumbing services, shall include, but not limited to equipment to clear plumbing stoppages of all types (including residential, commercial, and institutional), equipment (whether owned, through rental, or via subcontractor) for jetting services, flushing and pumping trucks, video camera and recording for interior and exterior line inspection with the capability to reach at least 300 linear feet.

**Exception: Exclusion of Pump Truck:** ColonialWebb does not own or operate a pump truck and have not provided pricing for this equipment/usage. We therefore request to be excluded from taking service calls that involve a pump truck. (We assume there will be awards to multiple contractors with at least one (1) supplier providing this service.) If this represents a hardship to Henrico County, we will consider providing a price for this service utilizing a subcontractor. Additional hourly costs for supervising the subcontractor would apply should the County want us to subcontract this work through ColonialWebb. We would be pleased to discuss this further during oral interviews scheduled for June, should we be invited.





## Tab 7 – Exceptions - Continued

## 2A. Reference Page 7 of 40, Item II.B.14.a:

**Exception: Water Jetter Limits of Liability:** Water jet operations entail the use of high volume and high-pressure water to clear pipes of accumulated materials on the walls of the pipes. Not knowing the latent condition of the pipes, joints, etc., the integrity of the piping system cannot be assured during or after Water Jetting Plumbing Services. Resultant damage, including but not limited to piping failures, water damage to floors or finishes and cleanup due to water backing out of drains or failure of pipes, shall be the responsibility of the County of Henrico. The County of Henrico shall hold ColonialWebb harmless against any and all resultant damage.

In addition, jet hoses may become stuck in drain piping due to defects or foreign matter. If excavation or mechanical means must be utilized for removal, an additional cost based on time and equipment will be charged to the County of Henrico. If removal is declined by the County of Henrico, they will be charged the retail cost of the damaged hose and nozzle.

## 3. Reference Page 8 of 40, Item II.C. Manufacturer's Warranty:

The County will use a manufacturer's approved service company for equipment currently under warranty. Payment for warranty repair services will be paid by the manufacturer of the equipment. If the Successful Offeror(s) is an authorized service company for the warranty repair, they may complete the service to manufacturer's specifications. The Successful Offeror(s) shall not submit an invoice to the County for payment; however, a service report/ticket shall be generated to document the warranty repair. The Successful Offeror(s) must produce supporting documentation to indicate they are an approved service company for the warranty repair.

**Exception:** ColonialWebb will provide labor warranty on any equipment we install commensurate with the contract requirements. Generally, we will not accept warranty calls on equipment that was installed by other contractors regardless of our status of being an authorized service agency. Reason: For Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing equipment, manufacturers typically only cover warranty on parts. The installation company covers the labor component. Thus, if we performed work during a covered warranty period on equipment another party installed, the manufacturer would not be obligated to pay us. Should there be an instance where the manufacturer was responsible for the labor warranty component then we would accept that type of call.





## Tab 8 – Assumptions

## i. Reference Page 8 of 40, Item II.B.14.g:

The County reserves the right to furnish materials and parts to the Successful Offeror(s). The Successful Offeror(s) shall keep an accounting of all items provided by the County and shall account for the use of those items on related service tickets. Unused items shall be returned to the County upon request by the County.

**Assumption:** ColonialWebb covers workmanship warranty on all repairs. However, it does not provide labor warranty on parts provided by others.

## ii. Reference Page 9 of 40, Item II.E.3:

The Successful Offeror(s) personnel shall be easily identifiable. Successful Offeror(s) shall provide identification badges with company name and logo to their personnel and shall be visibly worn at all times while on County Property.

**Assumption:** The solicitation defines required information on "identification badges" as company name and logo. ColonialWebb assumes the County of Henrico would accept a logo shirt or uniform as identification in lieu of identification badges. If this is not acceptable, we can create badges for our technicians with other required information as needed.

Please make the following corrections, deletions and/or additions to the above referenced RFP:

#### **Change of Proposal Receipt Date:**

1. The Proposal Receipt Date is changed to May 30, 2024, at 2:00 PM.

#### **Changes to RFP:**

1. Revise Sec. II(A)(2) (page 2 of 40) to read as follows:

The Successful Offeror(s) shall be a fully staffed operational service office, currently engaged in providing on call plumbing service, repair, maintenance, and replacement of existing plumbing systems; provide 24-hour emergency services as needed and requested; located within 35 miles (as defined by https://www.google.com/maps) of the County of Henrico Purchasing office located at 8600 Staples Mill Road, Henrico, Virginia 23228; have under their employment a minimum of four (4) journeyman plumbers, with a minimum of one (1) licensed journeyman plumber or licensed master plumber who will supervise any non-licensed plumbers, dedicated to this contract with the ability to respond to two or more service requests; and equipment to meet the requirements as outlined in the Scope of Work/Services.

2. Revise Sec. II(A)(4) (page 2 of 40) to read as follows:

The Successful Offeror(s) must ensure that at least one plumber licensed by the DPOR Board for Contractors is always on a job site supervising any plumbers who do not have DPOR Board for Contractors' licenses. The Successful Offeror(s) shall be responsible for providing the appropriate types and skill levels of personnel required to accomplish the necessary work. Offeror shall include with their proposal a list of plumbers capable of performing the requirements of this Contract and indicate whether each plumber has a DPOR Board for Contractors license and whether each plumber will be acting in a supervisory capacity. The Successful Offeror must provide copies of the DPOR Board for Contractors license of each licensed plumber on its list. The Successful Offeror(s) shall be responsible for providing an updated list of licensed plumbers to the County's Purchasing Division as changes are made.

- 3. Revise Sec. II (B)(10.B.) (page 5 and 6 of 40) to read as follows: Henrico County Public Schools and School Administration Buildings normal school hours, with the exception of serving times for breakfast and lunch, are Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and summer hours shall be Monday through Thursday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Work must not interfere with school activities or when conducting testing (SOLs).
- 4. DELETE ATTACHMENT H in its entirety and REPLACE it with Revised ATTACHMENT H in Addendum No. 1.

#### **Questions and Answers**

- 1. Reference page 3 of 40, item II.B.3.a.
  - a. How does Henrico County define "Emergency services"? Answer: Waterline break, running water, no water, backed up sewer, standing water, anything that may disrupt the operation of the building and or be a hazard to staff and public.

- b. Will "Emergency services" be assigned a Not-To-Exceed (NTE) amount by the county at the time the service call is placed? Answer: No.
- c. Will the contractor be able to bill emergency services based off of an established NTE? Or will a quote in arrears of the work be required in order to invoice? Answer: Time and Material Not to Exceed Price.
- d. For Emergency work, how would work authorizations occur? (i.e., Purchase Order per event or blanket Purchase Order, other?)
   Answer: Verbal Authorization will be given based on a Not to Exceed Price and PO will be issued per event.
- 2. Reference pages 4 & 5 of 40, items II.B.5 and II.B.6.
  - a. Can the county provide a description of the circumstances under which a quote is required? Answer: Quotes should be given for all work, unless given verbal authorization to proceed in an emergency.
  - b. If scope is not fully definable and troubleshooting is required to develop a scope of work and price a repair, will the county pay for the required labor to troubleshoot? Sample scenario:
    - Henrico County calls to get a quote on repairing a clogged drain- line. (Non-emergency, quote requested)
    - At the time of the request to quote the contractor may not know if the line can be cleared by snake, if a jetter is required or if there is damage to a pipe that may require a camera and locator.
    - Trouble shooting may be required which could require many man hours of labor.
    - Suppose the county decides to abandon the line or not make the repair.
    - Item II.B.6. prohibits charging for "time to inspect the worksite and to develop the written nonbinding estimate." Question: Since all of the above actions were required to arrive at a scope and firm quote, could the troubleshooting be billed?

Answer: Yes, troubleshooting costs can be billed for.

3. Reference Pages 5 & 6 of 40, items II.B.10 (Normal Business Hours) and II.B.13 (Successful Offeror(s) paid hourly rate per man hour).

The RFP states "normal business hours" for General Government and Schools to be Monday through Friday, 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. Other facilities such as "Jail East, Jail West, Juvenile Detention, Recreation and Parks" differ. Will the county pay "Overtime Hourly Rate" for work outside of the General Government normal business hours of Monday through Friday, 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. at a facility such as Jail East, Jail West and Juvenile Detention? Or, does the county expect to pay "Regular Hourly Rate" situationally to the facility? Example: A call comes in for Juvenile Detention that a contractor runs during a weekday between 5:00 P.M. and 7:00 P.M. Would the contractor bill at the "Regular hourly Rate" or the "Overtime Hourly Rate"?

Answer: Yes, the county expects to pay the Regular Hourly Rate situationally to the facility. In addition, school hours are not the same as General Government. Please refer to Item #3 under Changes to RFP.

4. Reference page 17 of 40, item V.W.1. & V.W.2.

This term appears to be inconsistent with contracts we have with other tax-exempt state agencies. Our company has been advised by legal counsel that there is no exemption from tax for contractor purchases that will be incorporated into real property of a tax-exempt entity. The only options we've been provided to avoid paying taxes when our end user is a tax-exempt entity are:

- The tax-exempt entity makes the material purchases directly.
- The tax-exempt entity names the contractor as an authorized purchasing agent.

Our legal department has advised us based on the way Item V.W.1. is written we would have to pay taxes on materials purchased but we could not recoup these real costs. Could this term be modified to allow the "Successful Offeror" to pass along these real costs to the county?

Answer: Page 7 of 40, Item 14(e) says, "The County will reimburse Successful Offer(s) for non-truck stock parts, materials, and components at cost." "At cost" would include sales tax the Successful Offeror paid. For

page 38 of 40, Attachment H Pricing/Cost Proposal, the Unit Price that the contractor lists for all truck stock items can include the sales tax.

- Reference page 19 of 40, Item V.DD.2.
   Skilled labor wage increases have often exceeded 3% per year. Would Henrico County agree to a preestablished annual rate increase that would not exceed the Bureau of Labor Statistics Construction Trade Contractors – NAICS Code 238220? Link here: <u>Bureau of Labor Statistics Data (bls.gov)</u> Answer: No.
- Reference page 38 of 40, Attachment H, Pricing/Cost Proposal.
   Column B Estimated Annual Hours, Item Nos 1-9 on pricing/cost proposal. Do the estimated hours in Column B include hours utilized by the schools, or do these hours just represent estimated non-school needs? Answer: Hours to be dictated by Henrico County General Government and Henrico County Schools staff.
- 7. Reference page 2 under II. Scope of Services, A. 2.,4. The proposal requires 4 DPOR licensed journeyman plumbers. Will the county accept plumbers that meet the journeyman plumber qualifications without the journeyman DPOR license? The state of Virginia allows service plumbing providers to work under one master plumbing license. Will Henrico County accept this State regulation? Answer: Yes. Refer to Items 1 and 2 under Changes to RFP.

All other specifications and General Terms and Conditions shall remain the same.

Offerors must take due notice and be governed accordingly. Failure to acknowledge this addendum may result in your response being deemed non-responsive.
